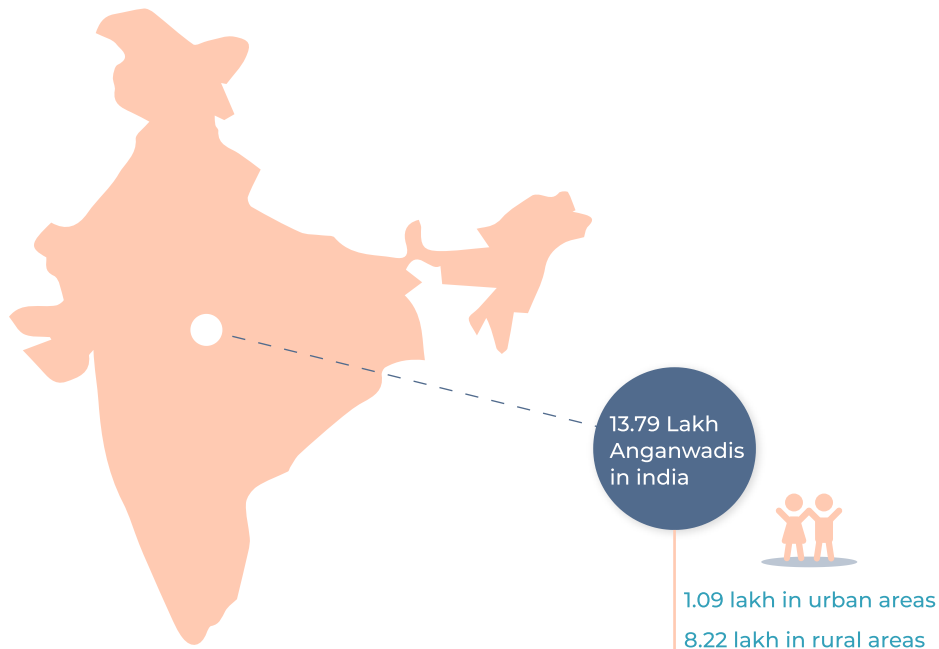

What is Anganwadi?

Anganwadi Centre is one of the important institutions to ensure nutrition and pre-school education of the children of age group 3-6 years.

There are as many as 13.79 lakh anganwadis operational across the country. Of those anganwadis that can be monitored online, 1.09 lakh centres are in urban areas and the remaining 8.22 lakh were in rural areas of the country, according to the RTI.



What happens in Anganwadi?

Children

- Kids are taken care when parents are off to work
- They are provided with basic primary education.
- They are provided with mid day meals.
- Food is cooked in the centre itself.
- Kids vaccination is done and recorded.

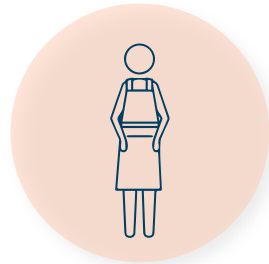
Pregnant women

- Pregnant women can visit for regular check ups.
- They are provided with nutrition charts.
- They are explained with different govt. schemes.

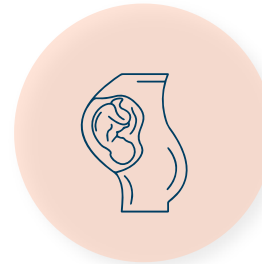

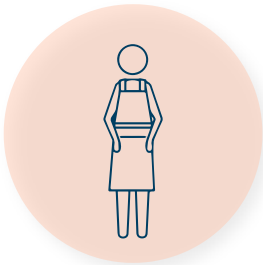
Teacher

- Provide basic and primary education.
- Registering new enrollment of kids.
- Write lesson plans and record kids progress.
- Guide pregnant ladies and enrolling them to schemes.
- Look after kids mid meals menu and nutrition.
- Record kids vaccination and record health.
- Look after the area and development.
- Send records to higher authorities.



Pregnant lady

- Enroll to different suitable schemes.
- Visit Anganwadi for regular checkups



Helper

- Take care of area and cleaning and maintenance.
- Help the teacher in looking after kids when she is busy with other work
- Cook mid day meals and feed kids.



Volunteer

- Look after infrastructure issues.
- Mostly NGOs.
- Donate books/ toys for kids.
- Help for 1 -2 days a week



Children

- Kids learn and play.
- Socialise and make friends.
- Education - basic language, math and art
- Have nap time.
- Play and run around.

Interview and field research

Visited 3 Anganwadi centres and gathered the information.

Discussion with Anganwadi teachers

- Center opens at 9. She usually reaches before.
- Kids attendance is taken and prayer is done.
- She teaches/ plays with the kids according to lesson plan created by her.
- Feels that space given is too less, can't avoid taking new enrollment of children.
- Food area, classroom, play area is same now, but new rules say that separate dining should be provided.
- When new family shifts to a given area, teacher makes sure that they are aware of the centre.
- Kids most of the time spread out and study.
- She talks to the helper and makes sure the cooking happens on time.
- Menu comes from higher authority every month. Its a weekly menu given.
- Every Tuesday - Doc is present for kids and pregnant ladies. The allotted day for doctor visit is different in all centres.
- When a new child wants to enroll, she fills the form with family details and ID proof.
- Post lunch she gives kids a break time / nap time, where she records today's activities in a register.
- In total, she maintains 6 registers - (every 6 months - records go to higher authority)
 1. Children's attendance
 2. Lesson plan and activities.
 3. Kids progress report.
 4. Kids health and nutrition.
 5. Kids enrollment
 5. Pregnant lady enrolment.
 6. Pregnant lady health records and registration for schemes.
- Books and curriculum is sent by govt. authorities. Kids are supposed to fill the worksheet attached with it.
- Each Anganwadi has audits on regular basis where the records are checked. Area is assessed.

Discussion with Helpers

- Arrives early in centre and cleans the area.
- Looks at the food ingredient and plans the cooking.
- Helps the teacher and takes care of kids when teacher is busy.
- Entertains and involves in kids activity.

Discussion with parents

- It's convenient for them, they know their kids are in safe hands.
- Parents - Construction labours, maids, daily wage workers.
- Just submit Aadhar card, photographs and enrolled kids.
- Happy that food is taken care of.
- This ensures that their kids are getting proper nutrition.
- Kids basic education is taken care of.
- Happy that festivals and events are celebrated. Kids participate and socialise.

Problem Statement

To develop a system that helps Anganwadi teachers to maintain records of students and pregnant ladies hassle-free. Currently, he/she maintains 6 different books on a daily basis. It becomes difficult to store the record books and send them for auditing purposes. It becomes difficult in locating a particular data of a student / Woman at a given point of time. Few of the records are misplaced or lost during storage/auditing purposes as they are sent to a different place.

Understanding problem statement.

Usually Anganwadi centres has max. 30 kids enrolled. It becomes difficult to record the details of all the kids manually. On an average, 5 -6 pregnant ladies approach these centres for their health and schemes. The teacher notes down their details and suggests them the appropriate schemes. She also organises, events that benefits them.

Thus, on a day to day basis her majority of the time goes away in writing and maintaining books.

What does the record book contain?

- Child enrollment process and parents details.
- Child's attendance
- Childs academic progress and lesson plans
- Child's health and nutrition.
- Pregnant lady enrollment.
- Pregnant lady health - nutrition and check ups
- Schemes that women enrolled in.

The area gets very crowded on check up Days. Those days are really hectic.

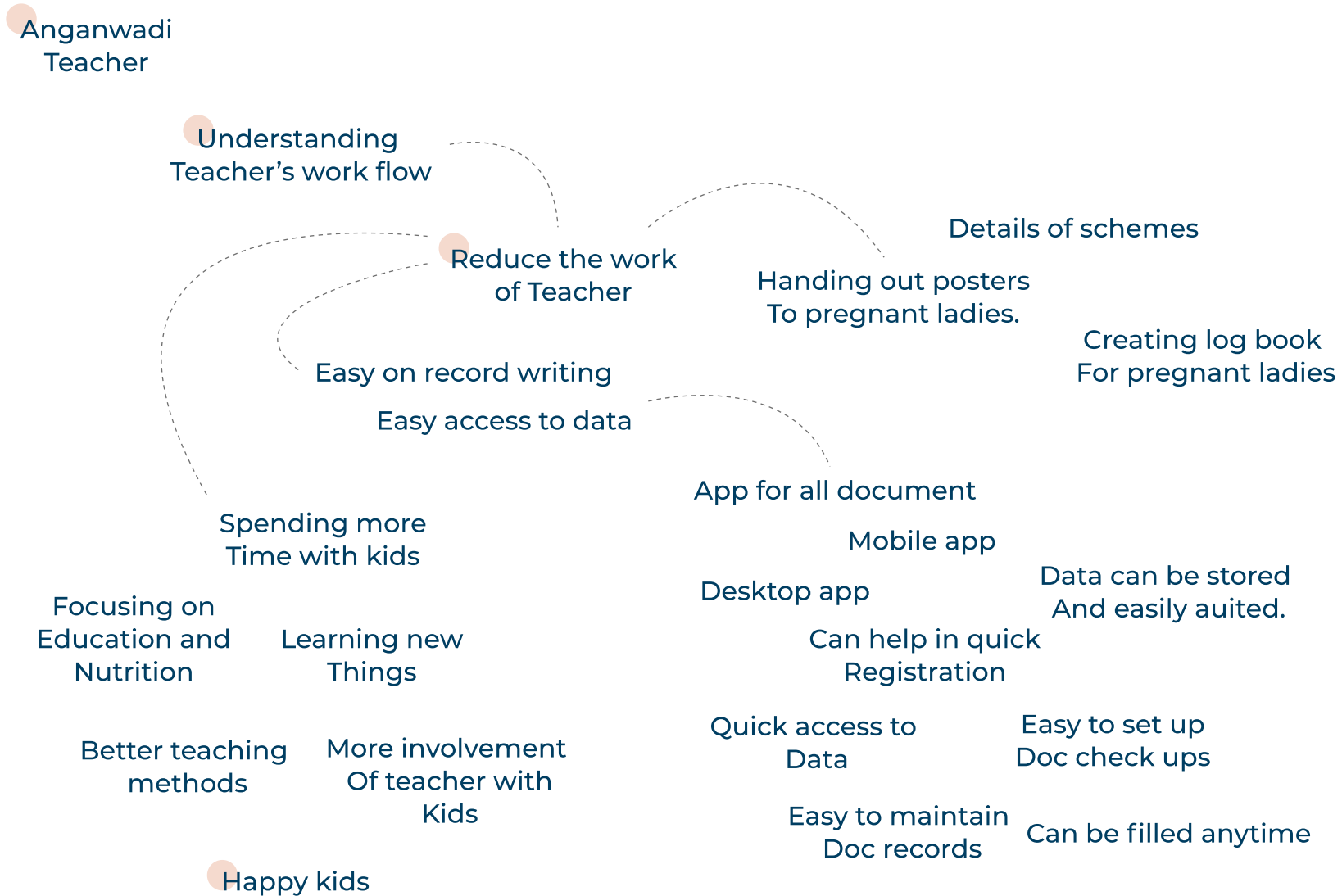
Pain points

Pregnant lady data and regular check ups can also be monitored and recorded.

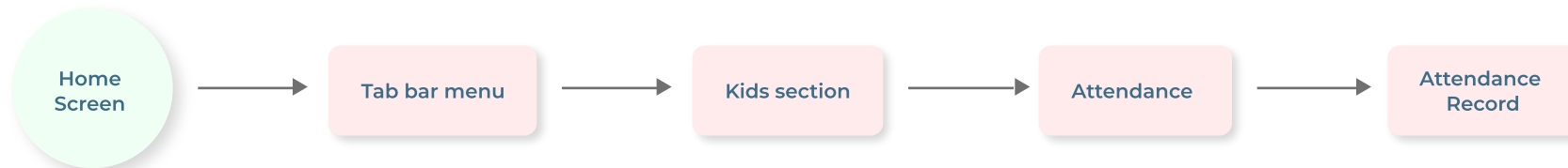

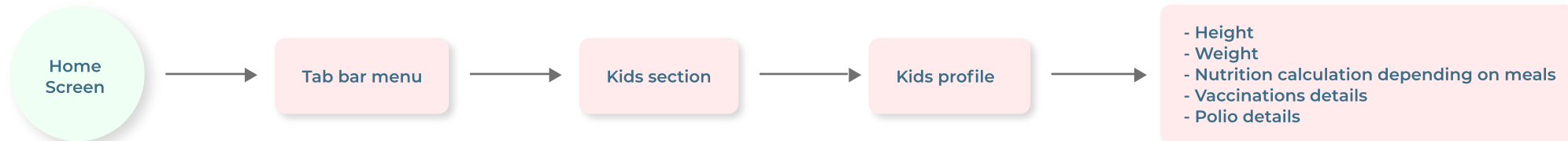

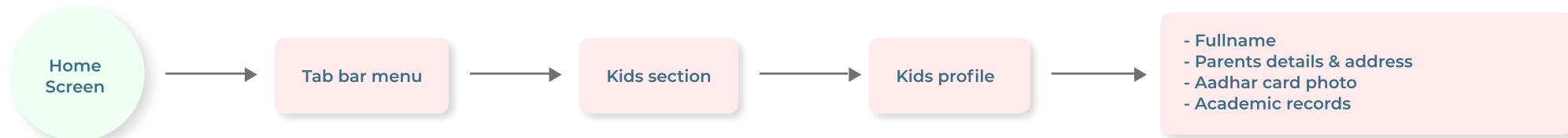

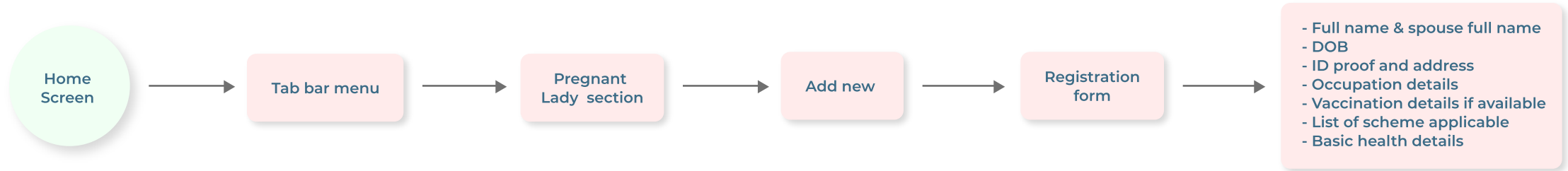

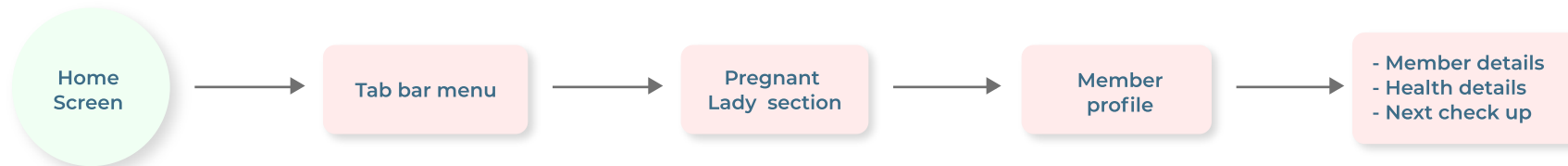

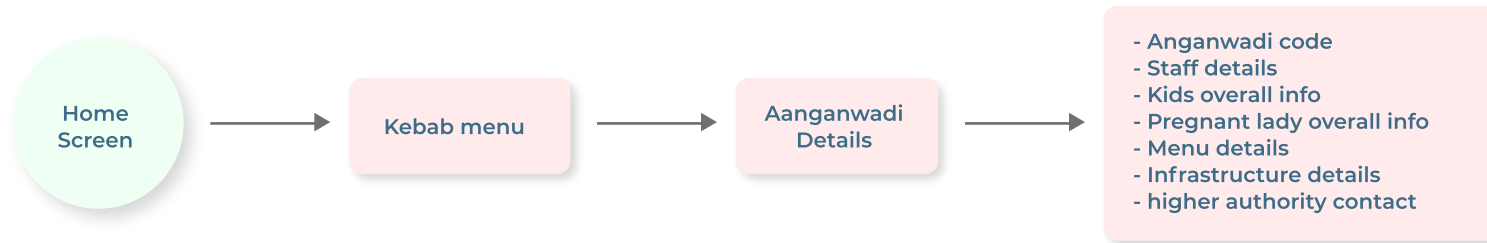


Member profile



User flows - Anganwadi related

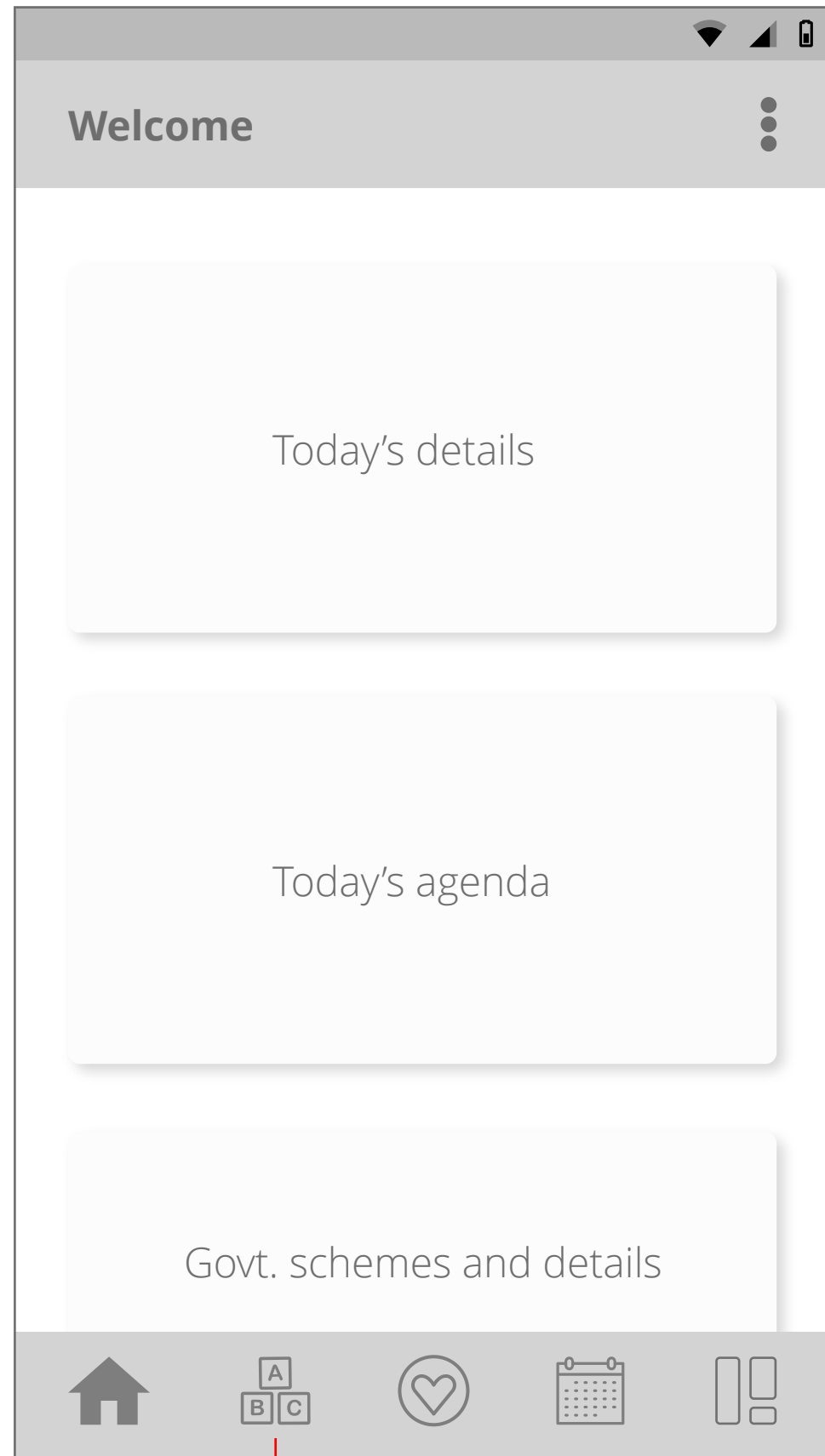

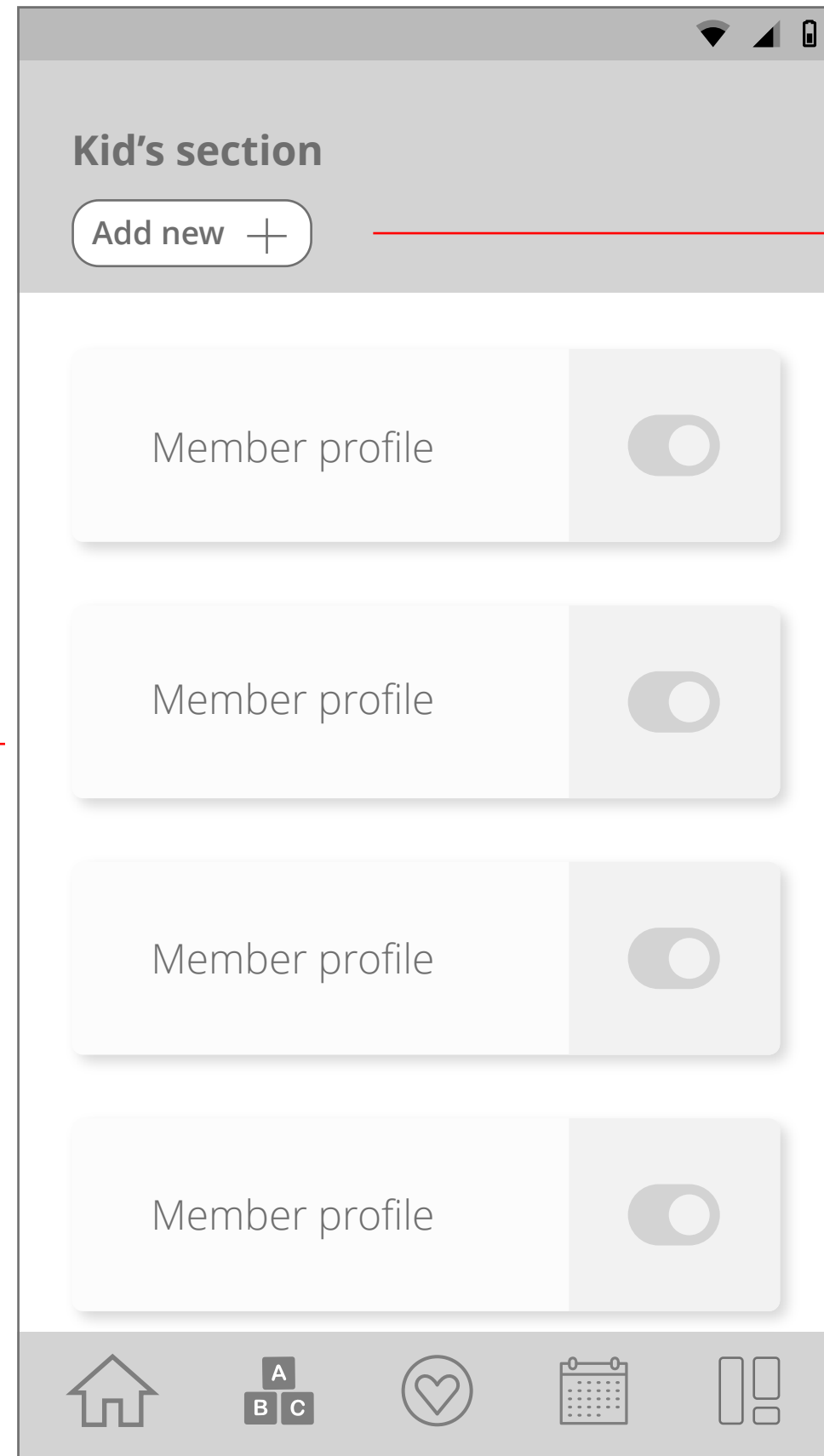

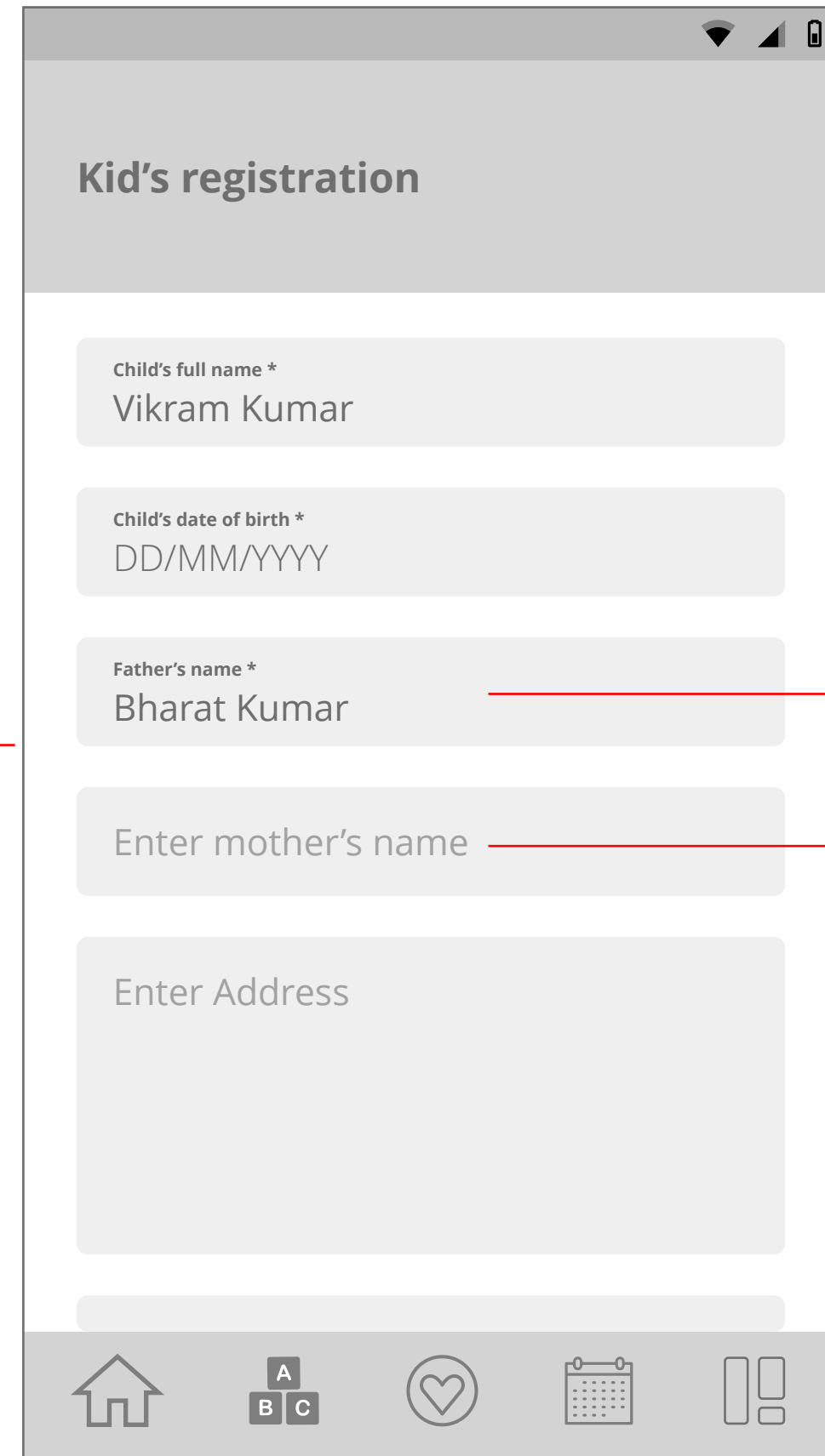

Kids section screen - Teacher can view profile, take attendance, register new kids. The floating ADD button leads to kids registration page.

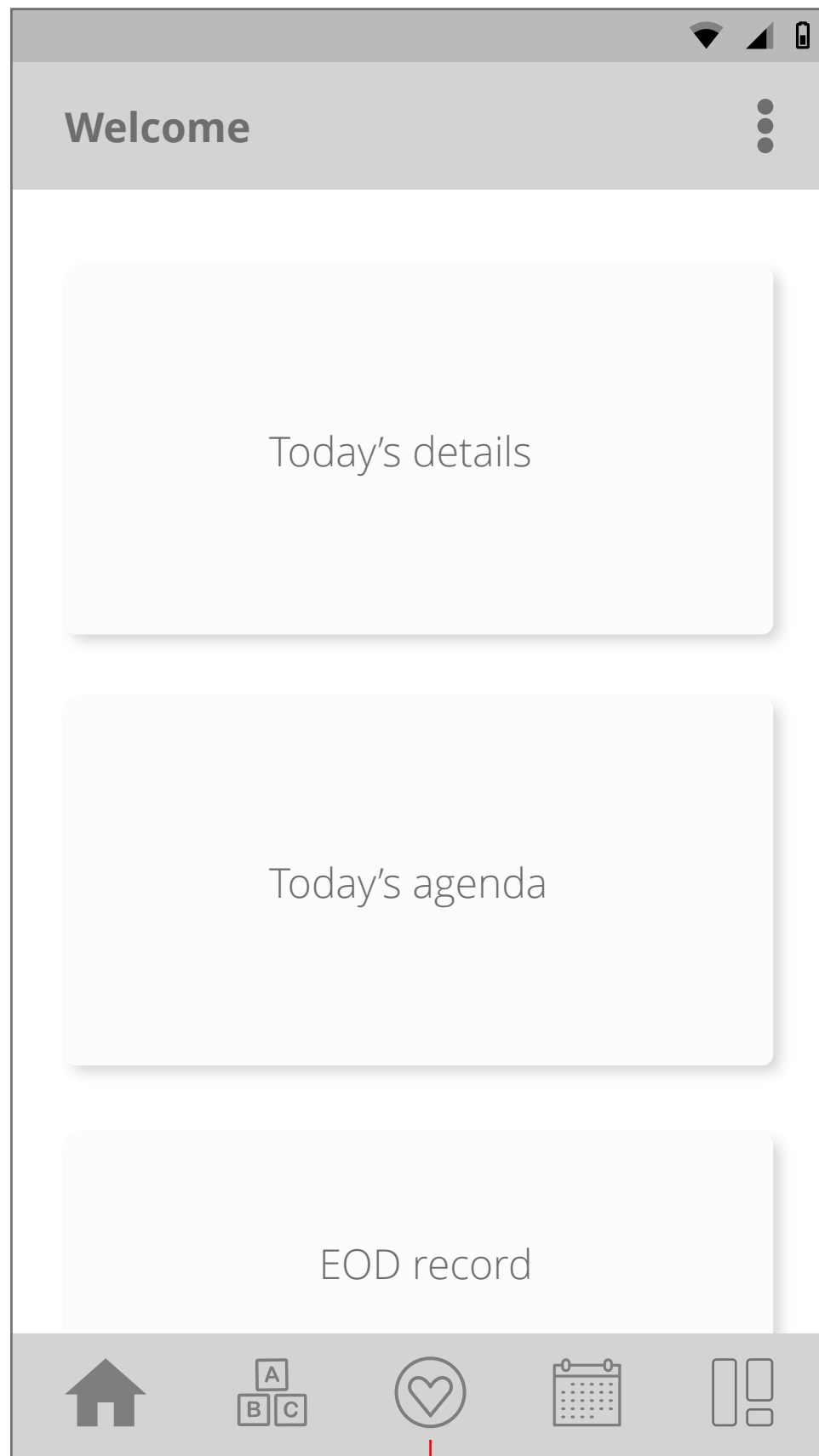

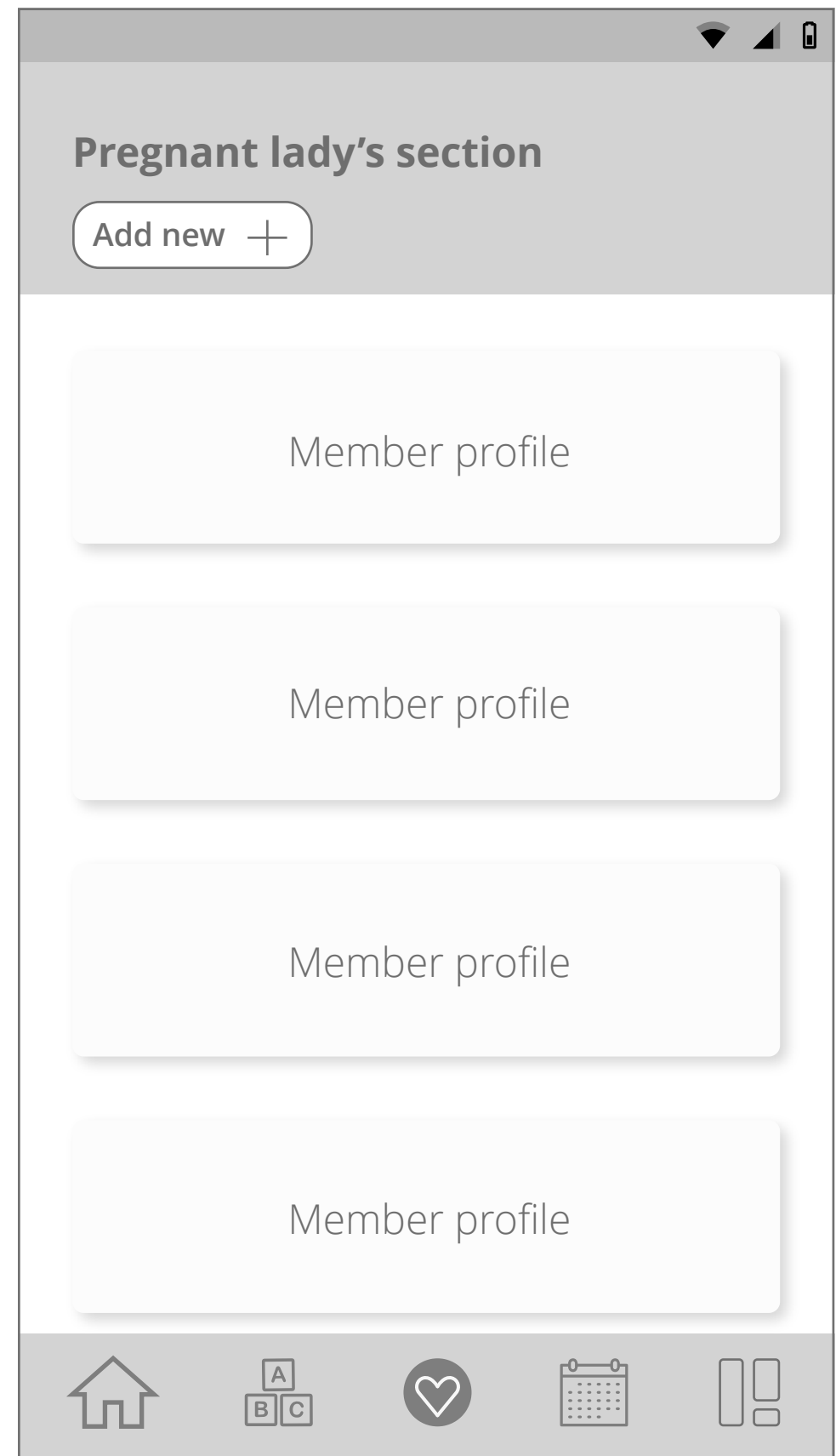
After the input is added, the input field looks like this.

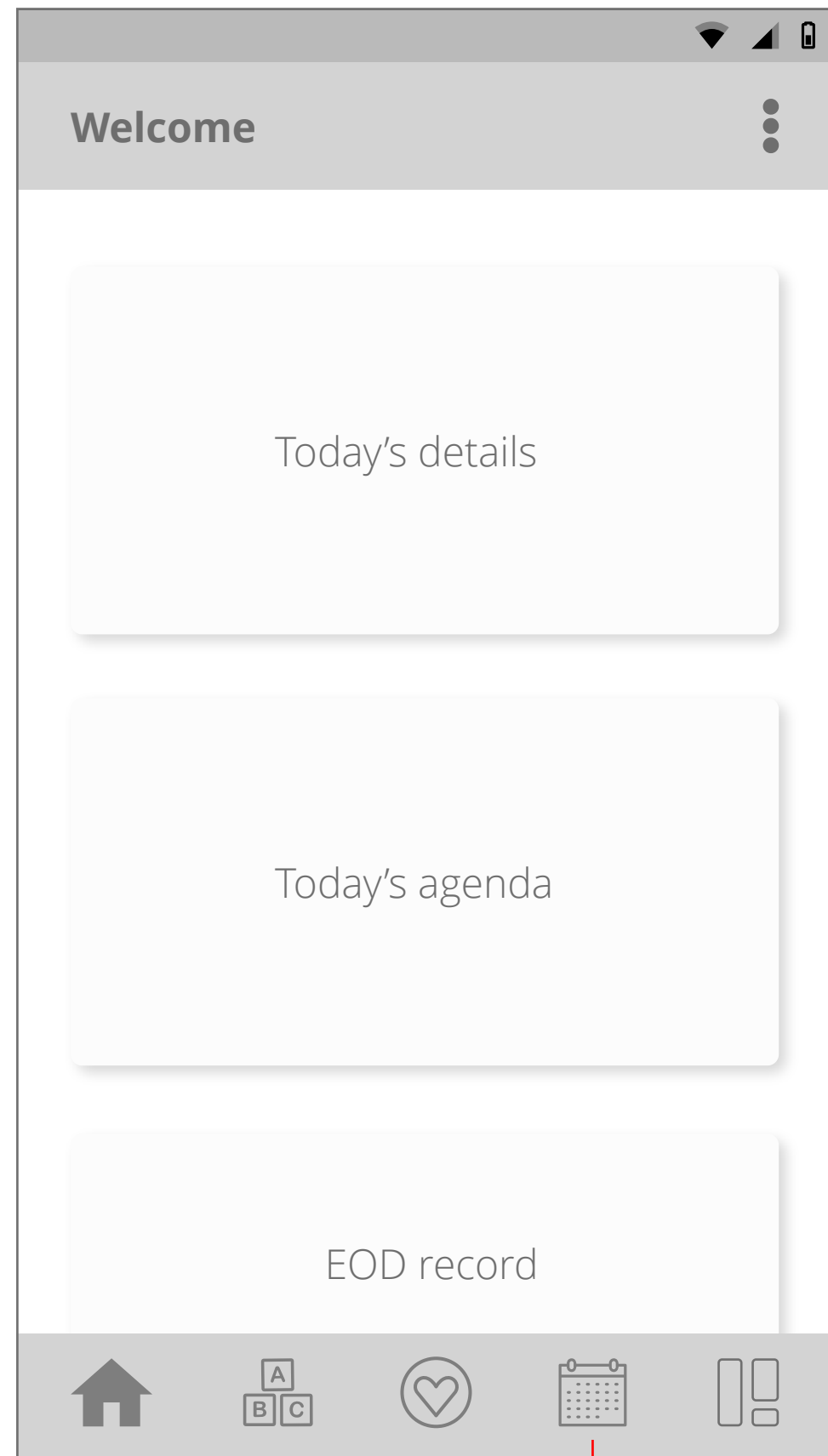

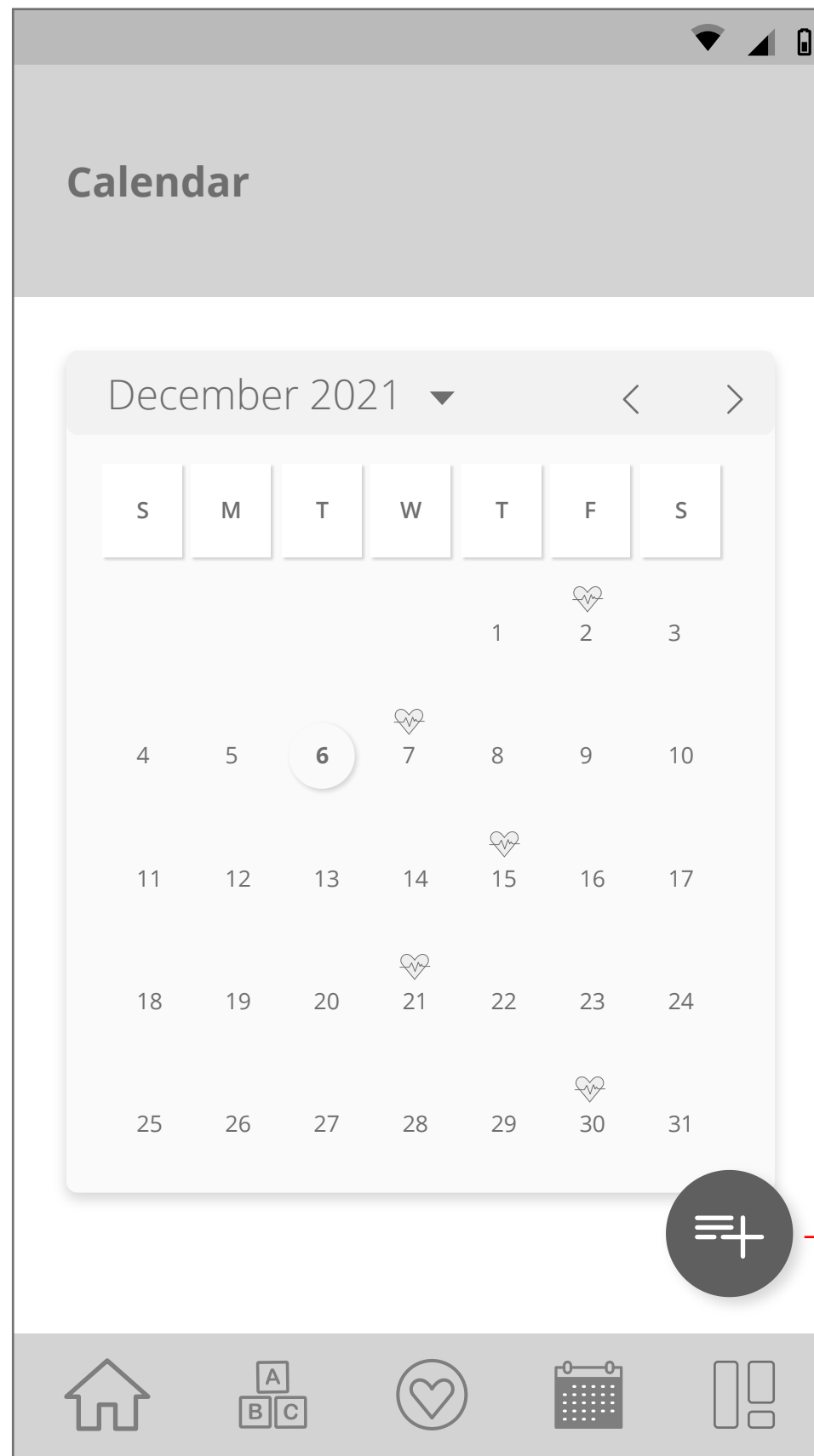


Pregnant lady screen - Teacher can view profile and register new member. The floating ADD button leads to member registration page.

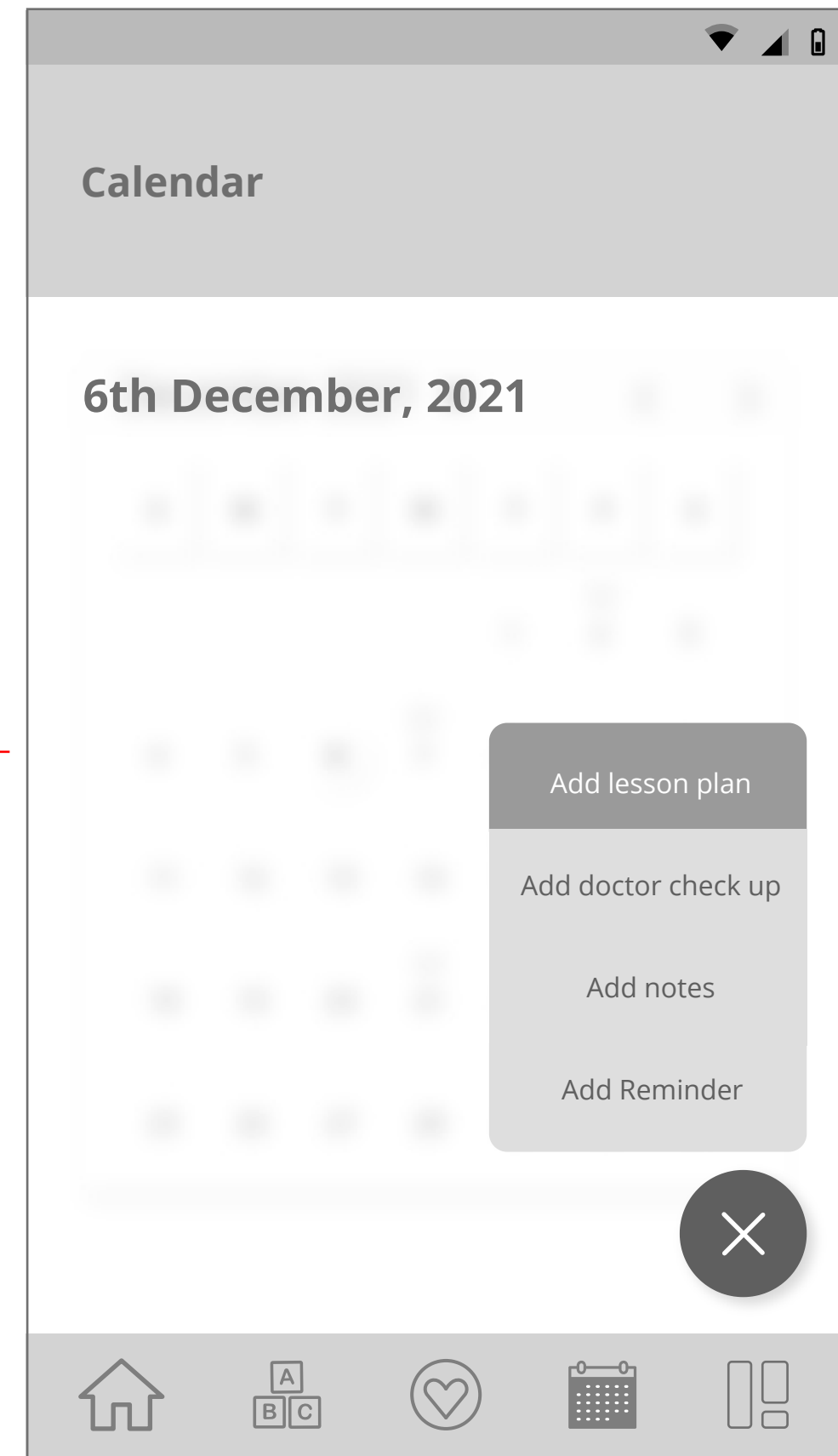

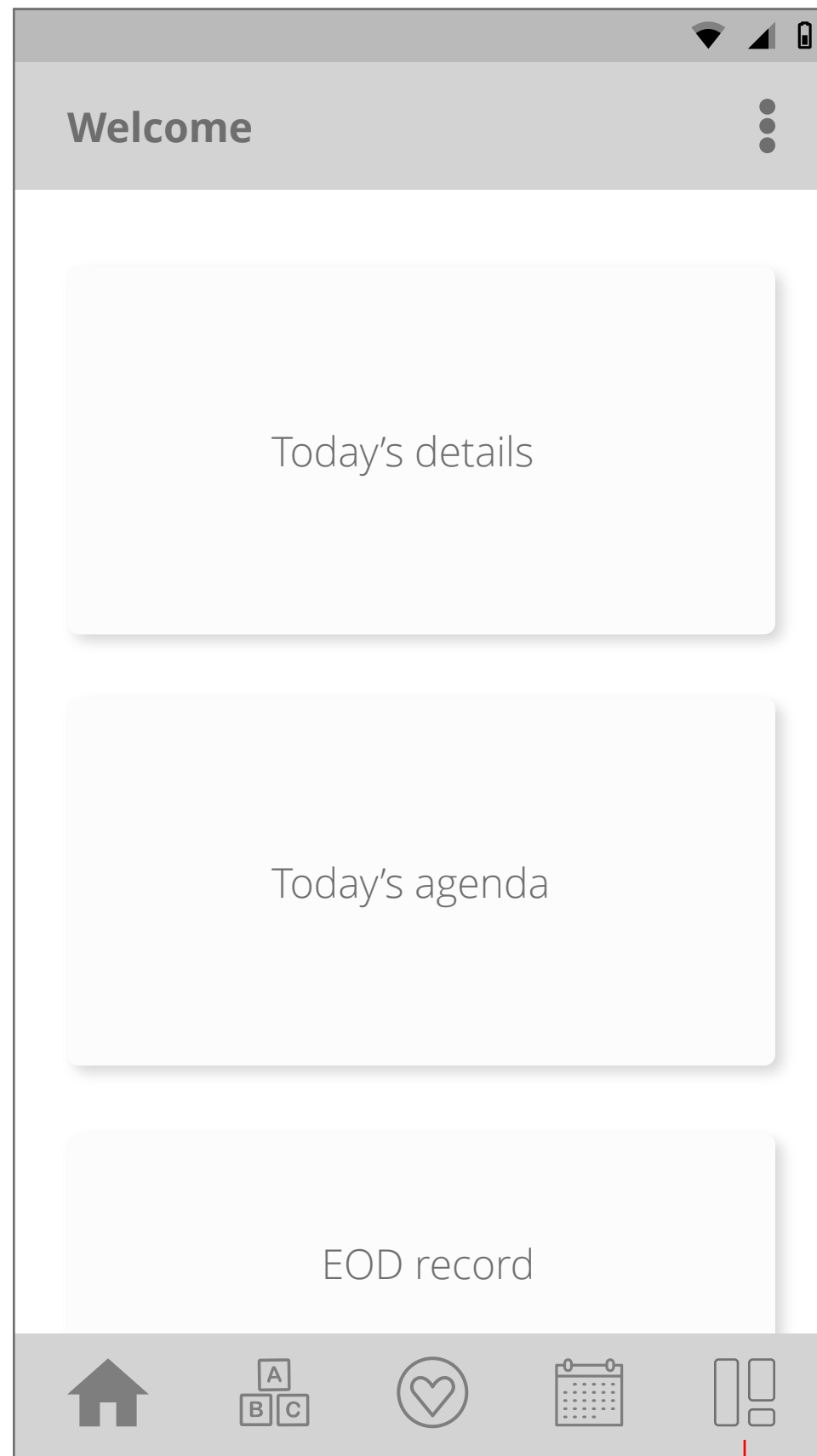

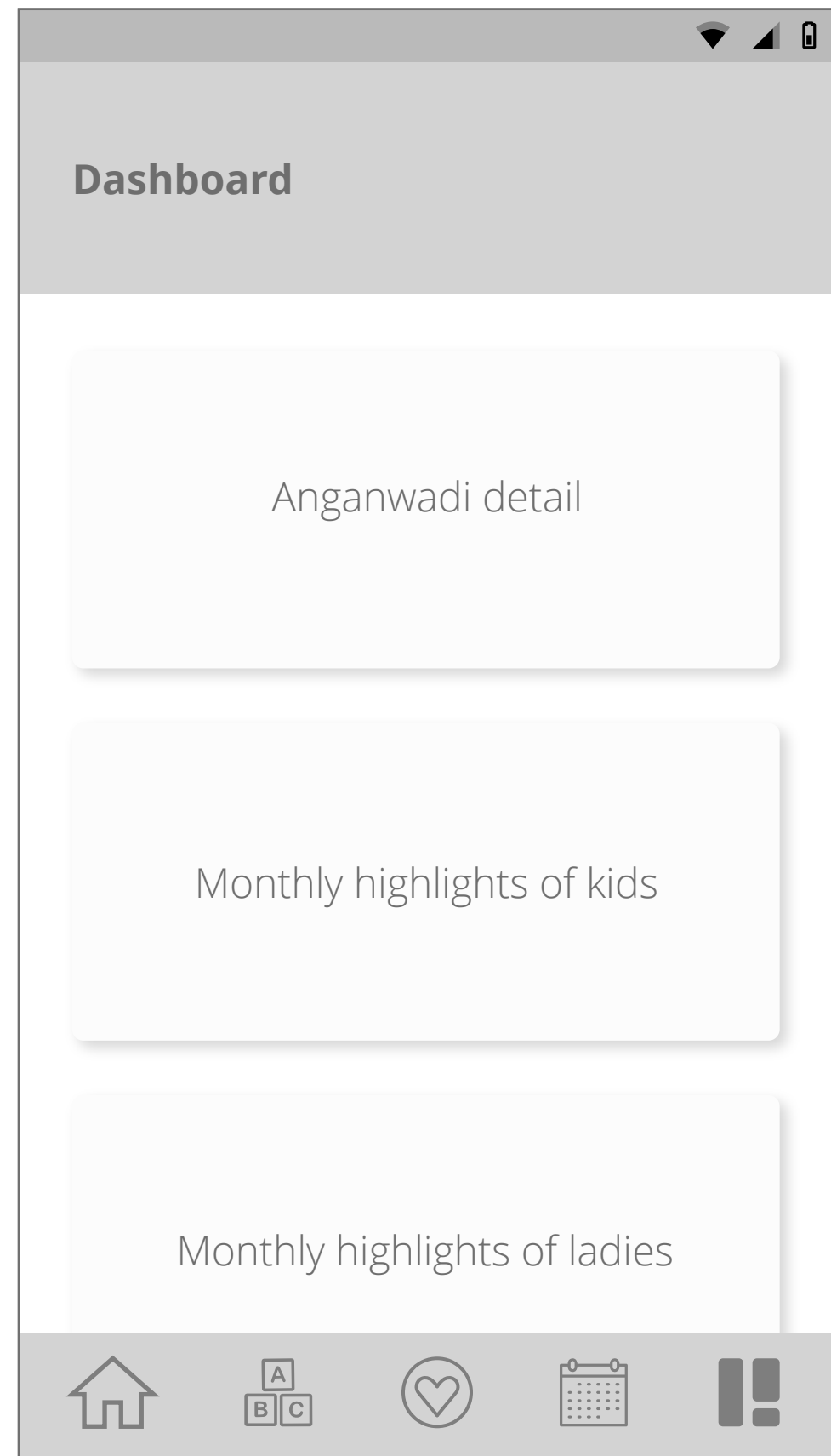

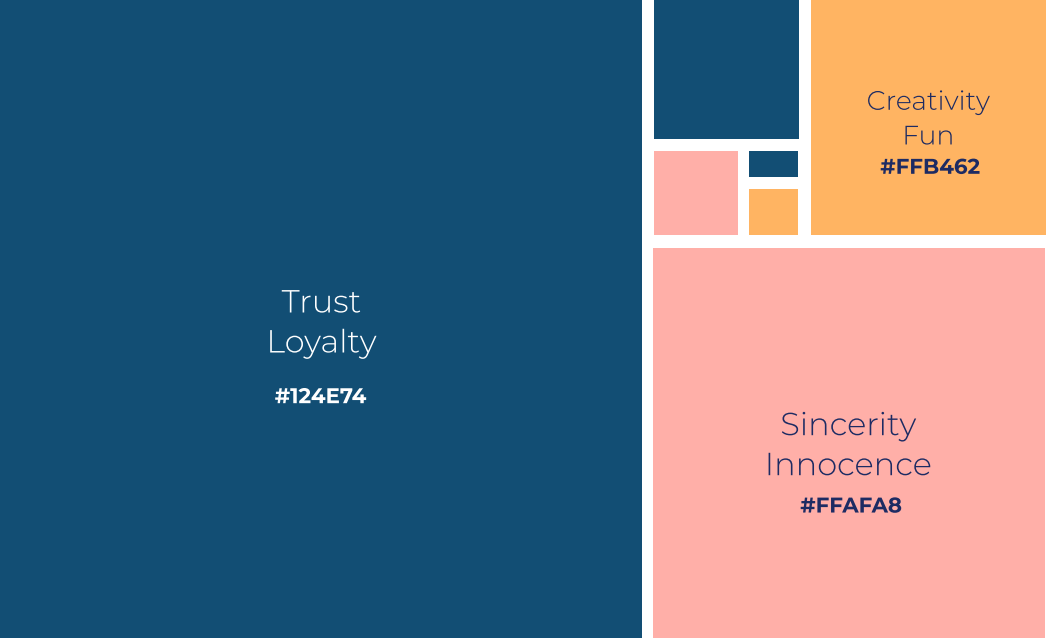
